Recently, co-op customers have received telephone calls from individuals falsely claiming to be co-op employees. Those callers have asked customers to give out or verify personal information.

If you receive such a call, do not give out your SMECO account number, address, or telephone information. SMECO employees do not ask customers for their address and telephone number when SMECO has a planned outage or when customers owe a past due balance on their electric bill; SMECO representatives will already have the necessary information.
